Mountains are magnets for man. It is not unusual for you to dream of relaxing on the very edge of a mountain, seeing a vast spectacle below and feeling the mountain air. Silent Valley welcomes you, to enjoy the massive spectacle of the mountain land of Nilgiris, to get lost in the wilderness for a night. The National Park management intends to involve genuine nature study groups in protection-oriented trekking and camping inside the forest.

The programme includes a 5 km trek to Keerippara Camp shed, which is located in the scenic spot above Attappady Ghat and overnight stay there. Being in an open terrain, the campers may get a good chance to observe wildlife in the hills and valleys sprawling all around. The landscape represents a different face of Silent Valley, but gives a perfect wilderness experience to the enthusiastic visitors. The visitor thus joins the Park protection team during the programme.

Keerippara is a vantage point on the Southern edge of Silent Valley and Silent Valley in turn is situated on the South Western corner of Nilgiris. The Attappady Ghat is entry point to the invincible fortress of Nilgiris from the Malabar Plains. Apart from travelling through a mosaic of landscapes- from rain forest to deciduous forests and then to rolling grasslands, this is an opportunity to camp in the mountains overlooking the Mannarkkad Plains. Be the sentinel of the mountain fortress for a night!
